"It was amazing that someone I had never met cared enough to put together this kit containing really thoughtful items that helped me through chemo. It was like receiving a virtual hug."



KEY ITEMS IN OUR CHEMO KITS

GINGER TEA BAGS

Nausea is one of the most common side effects of cancer treatment, and this is a healthy way to soothe discomfort.

THICK, TOASTY WARM SOCKS

Because people undergoing treatment can experience very cold extremities.

SENSITIVE TOOTHPASTE

Many chemotherapy patients suffer from sensitive teeth and this can help reduce the painful sensitivity.

HAND CREAM

Dry skin is a common side effect, both during and after treatment. A small, unscented hand cream is included to soothe dry and chapped hands.

LIP BALM

A moisturising lip balm is included to soothe chapped lips, which can also be a side effect of cancer treatments.
