In 2022 we were able to provide much needed emotional and practical support to 6,611 people.

Our vision to create a kinder world for those impacted by cancer provides a clear call to action and we are focused on delivering positive impact by continuing and expanding our highly valued free services, Cancer Kits and Cancer Coach.

We have used our expertise in providing emotional support to gather insight and establish a growing need to support those impacted by cancer in the workplace.

55% of our Cancer Coach participants stated that they needed more support in returning to the workplace. We have now successfully started working with organisations to deliver

specialist training, which will ensure they are equipped to provide support by having better conversations with those impacted directly or indirectly by a diagnosis.

This third area of service delivery is aligned to our purpose and is an essential element of achieving our future vision.

Income generated from the training services will provide essential funds to further support the much-needed expansion of the free Cancer Coach and Cancer Kits services.

At a time of continued financial challenge, we continue to innovate to ensure we deliver as much impact as efficiently and effectively as we can, while always exploring how we can expand our services in a sustainable way.

Our primary operational activity is to raise funds to enable the charity to deliver its services.

Outcome: Increase number of Cancer Coach applications. Increase number of individual donations, regular giving. Encourage people to fundraise on behalf of Cancer Support UK.

Increase understanding and empathy with funders, partners and the general public

Outcome: Increase the number of participants to our services through direct and partnership channels, such as referrals to Cancer Coach from health professionals. Increase and grow our supporter base across individuals and grant making organisations to increase our resources to expand our services.

what makes us different




